



MHO NETWORKS PUBLIC DYNAMIC IP AGREEMENT

Requirements:

1. I understand that all ports used to run servers will be blocked, including: 80, 25, 110, 20, 21 and 23 (HTTP, SMTP, POP3, FTP, TELNET, ETC.); no servers are allowed on this connection.
2. I understand that changing my IP Address from private to public (or vice versa) is free the first time. There will be a \$25 setup fee for each additional change after the first free modification.
3. I have read and understand all of the terms in the MHO Networks Customer Agreement.
4. I am aware that my bandwidth usage will be monitored by MHO Networks.
5. I understand that the IP address I receive is dynamic and will change.
6. I understand that if I abuse the terms of service located in the MHO Networks Customer Agreement, I may have my account terminated without any refunds.

Abuse Policy (Taken From MHO Networks Customer Agreement: <http://mho.com/info/legal.php>)

7. Customer is responsible for ensuring that their usage of the Services does not improperly restrict, degrade or adversely affect any other user's use of the Services, nor represent, in MHO's sole judgment, an unusually large burden on the network itself. Client must comply with the then current bandwidth, data storage and other limitations on the Services.
1. If MHO determines that client's account is exceeding the bandwidth limits, they will be notified by e-mail.
 2. If the excess use continues for more than 48 hours, the Services may be suspended or terminated.
 3. If excessive bandwidth utilization is determined by MHO to adversely affect MHO's ability to provide the Services for its other customers, immediate action may be taken to alleviate the problem. In such event, you will be notified by e-mail as soon as practicable.
